

Defendant in Actors' Alleged Kidnapping will be Represented by Richie Litigation, P.C.

Twenty-six-year-old Amber Neal was charged this month with six felony counts in relation to the alleged kidnapping of two Los Angeles actors. Authorities allege that Neal, alongside Keith Andre Stewart and Johntae Jones, kidnapped actor Joseph Capone and *Halloween: Resurrection* actress Daisy McCrackin on May 3, 2017.

This outrageous violation of Ms. Neal's rights under California law is but one example of the woefully inadequate, incompetent, and illegal investigation of Ms. Neal in this matter. Needless to say, Ms. Neal is not guilty of these charges and she looks forward to proving her innocence before the jury of her peers at trial."
